

The office staff will be sending out Data Collection sheets after the half term for you to amend any errors.










Pupil premium is additional funding we may receive to help your child's learning and development. We receive Pupil Premium for each pupil registered as eligible for free school meals (FSM) at any point in the last 6 years. You may not be aware your child is entitled to FSM and this is why we are asking parent to check their eligibility now.

Children in KSI who receive Universal Free School Meals (UFSM) do not automatically qualify for Pupil Premium, we still need parents to apply for FSM.

Primary schools receive £1320 per year for each Pupil Premium child, therefore it is really important that we receive the funding your child is entitled to, to help with their education. Please see the poster below outlining the criteria for FSM
