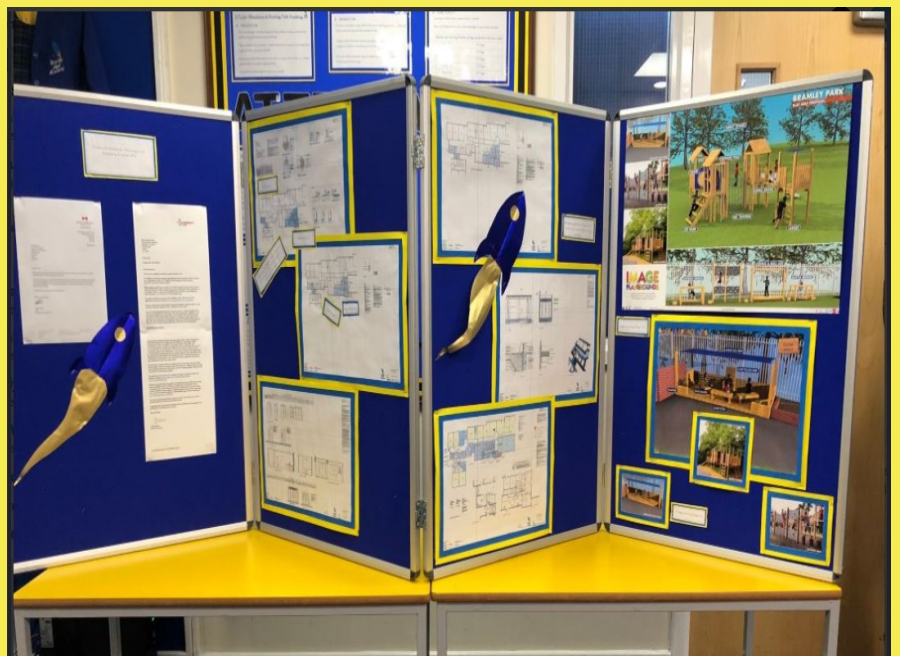

Arriving to school on time.

At present the issue of pupils arriving late is become a problem. Please can we ask all Parents/Carers to please bring your child to school on time. Once in school, learning starts straight away with our EarlyBirds Maths. Children who are late are missing out on valuable learning time.

Lateness is monitored daily and frequent episodes of lateness will be documented and parents/carers will be challenged on this.

Lunch, Rockets and Nursery Fees.

If you pay for school lunches, access our wraparound facility or pay for extra hours at Nursery, can we please remind people that regular payments need to be made. If regular payments are not received then these facilities will not be available until outstanding debt is covered.

If Lunch debt becomes over £25 then dinners will be stopped and a packed lunch will need to be provided.



Please can we remind parents/carers that leggings, jeans, jogging pants etc. are not part of the school uniform. Parents/Carers who are regularly sending their children in inappropriate school uniform will be contacted and asked to come into school with the correct items.

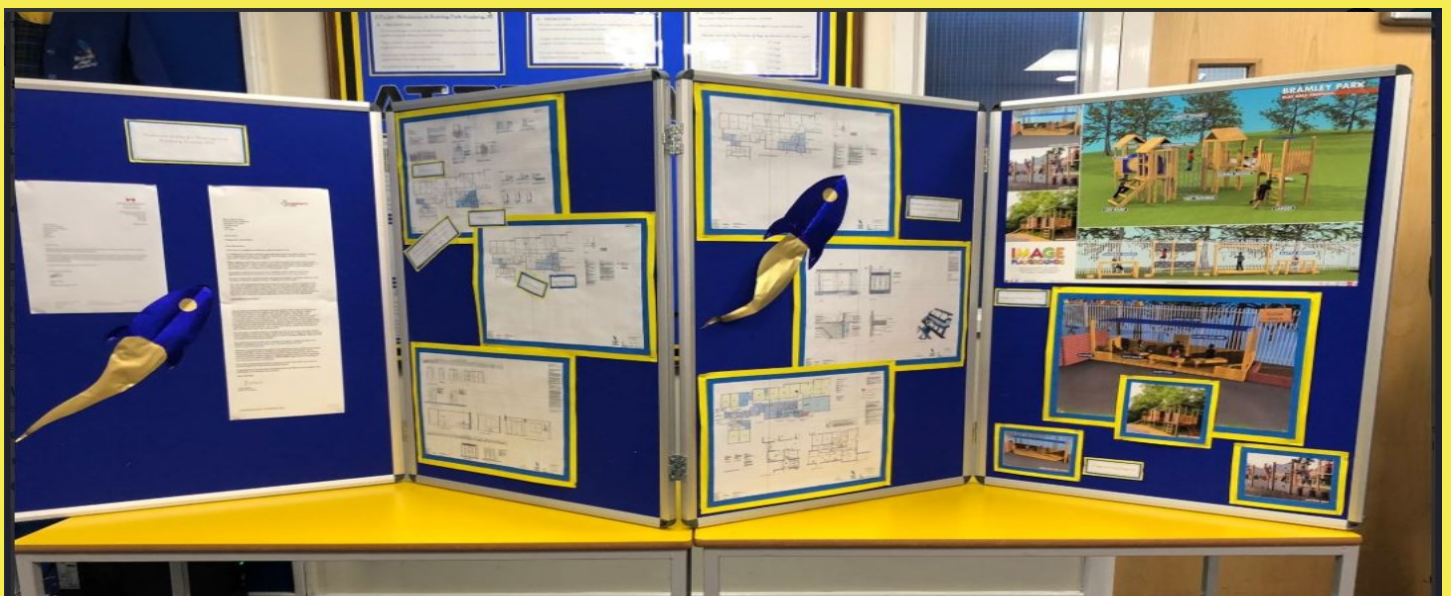



Year 3 went to Lotherton Hall last week and Year 4 went to Yorkshire Sculp-

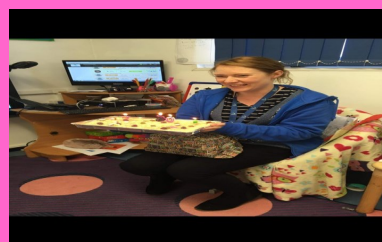
