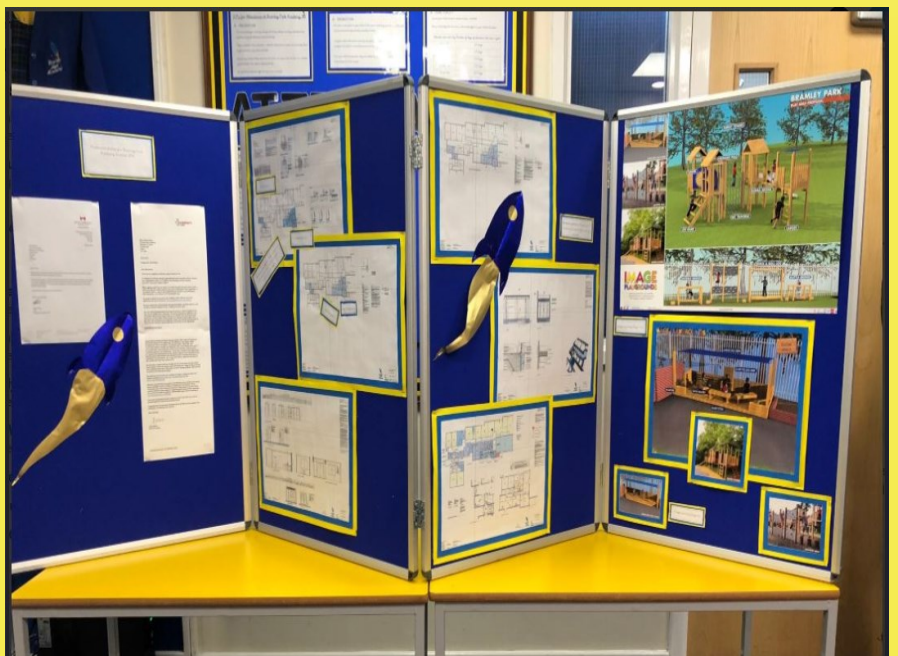

Arriving to school on time.

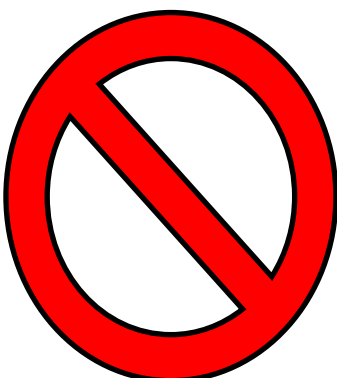

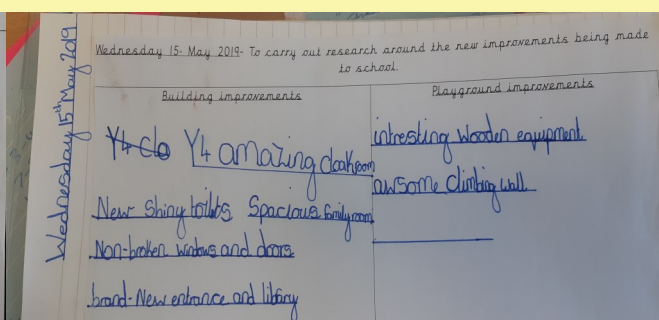
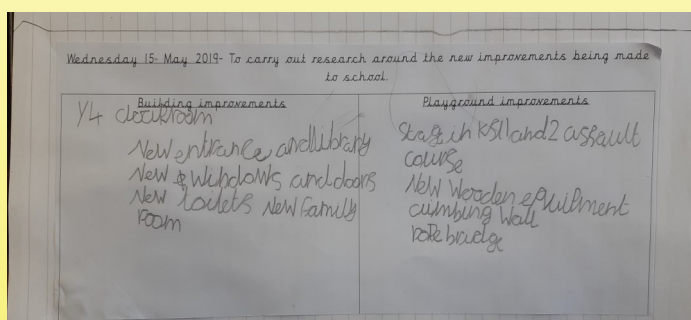
