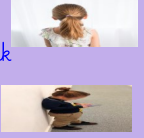
This week we have had several visitors from members of staff at other schools in Wellsprings Academy Trust. They were all very impressed with the school and the children here. Please read the feedback we received:

How to register:

1. Go to www.hdft.nhs.uk/leeds-consent
2. Click on the link in the grey box which says 'click here for the online consent form'.
3. Enter the school code 146542 and click 'find school'
4. Complete the form with your child's information and parent/guardian contact information.
5. Click the green 'submit' button.
