However, I must highlight the increasing amount of stress, and aggression which is being directed towards school staff by parent/carers. This has become unbearable this week and is actually taking staff away from supporting children in school.

Please remember all of the guidelines are issued and directed to us by the Government. Everyone needs to play their part to help the reduction of the pandemic. Staff at Bramley Park Academy **DO NOT DESERVE TO BE SPOKEN TO (OR TREATED) IN AN UNPLEASANT MANNER DUE TO THE CURRENT GUIDELINES.**

You can play your part by:

- Adhering to social distancing on the school site
- Ensuring only 1 parent per family collects pupils
- Speaking positively to school staff
- Speaking positively to other parent/carers
- Acting as a good role model at all times.
- Adhering to the 6 person per household rule.
- Ensuring your pupil only brings a SCHOOL BAG to school.
- Wearing a facemask on the school site (if possible).
- Pupils do not come to school with COVID19 symptoms
- Pupils remain at home until test results have been returned.

Please note any flouting of current guidelines imposed by the government in household is a police matter and I would urge you to contact 101 if you are concerned.
