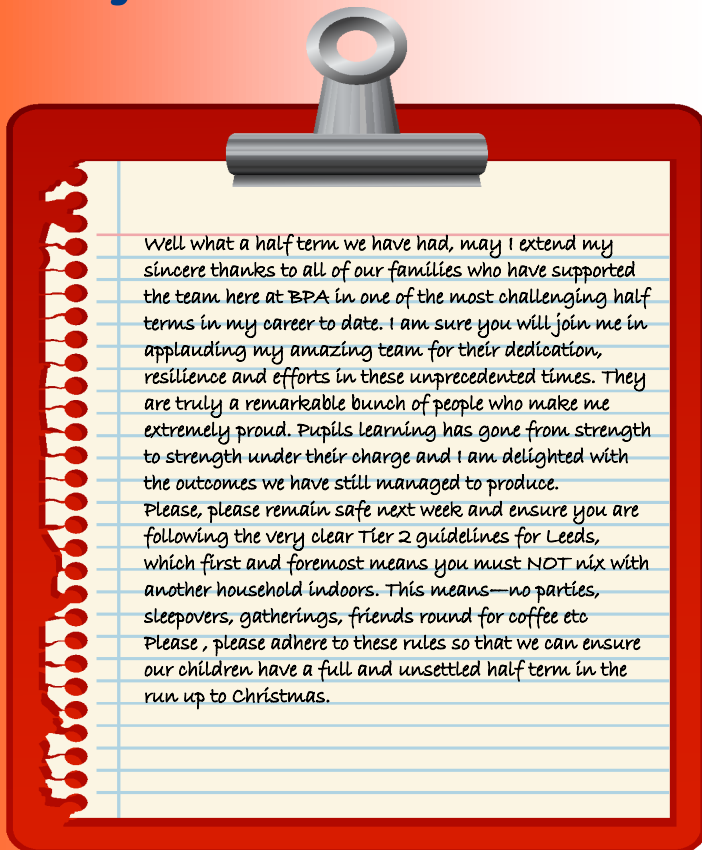


Bramley Park Academy Newsletter
