Who can help?

Mrs Dove and Mrs Willetts have responsibility for attendance in school and are available to give advice and support regarding anything relating to this.

At Bramley Park Academy we believe that: -

We recognise that regular school attendance is vital. Children need to attend regularly if they are to enjoy the educational opportunities provided within the school and make consistently good progress. Absence can lead to educational disadvantage for a child and place them at risk of not achieving their full potential.

What do I do if my child has a medical or dental appointment?

Please try to make appointments out of school hours. If this is not possible you will need to inform the school office.Children must attend school until the appointment time and be returned afterwards.You will need to bring evidence of your appointment a card/letter when you collect him/her from school.
