Welcome back everyone to the start of our summer term. I do hope everyone managed to have a restful Easter break.

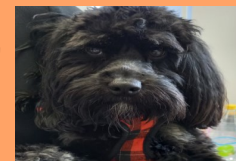

As the warmer weather is approaching please remember to send your child with a sun hat and suncream applied each day.

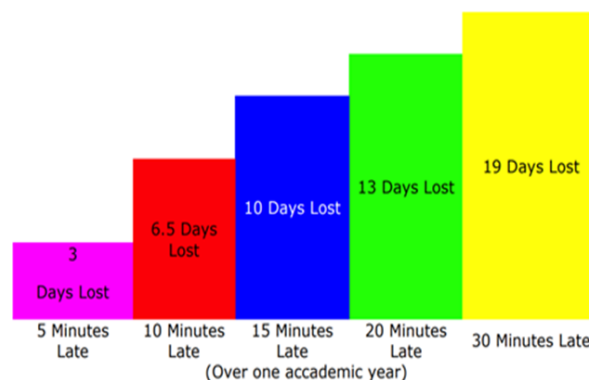
