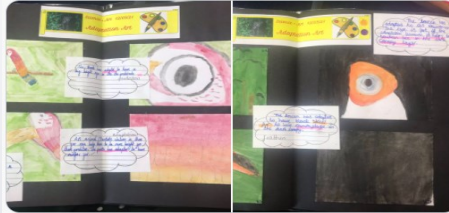


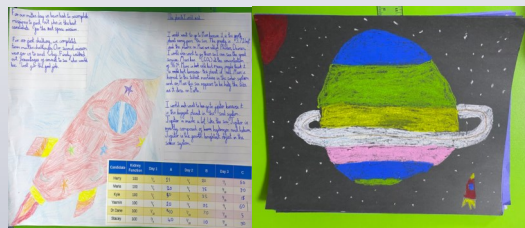
We have had a lovely start to the summer term. Please take a look at all the great learning and fun activities we have done after returning from the Easter break.

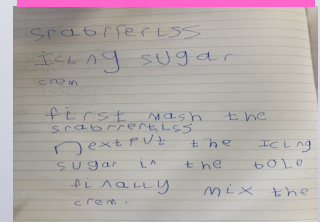
Wow - some amazing adaptation art from Year 5 on rainforest animals

**The Hobbits: Tyler** - for bringing in his reading book everyday!

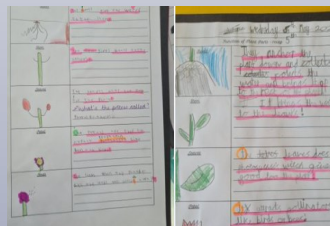
**The Borrowers: Archie** - for an excellent argument during our deforestation debate.
