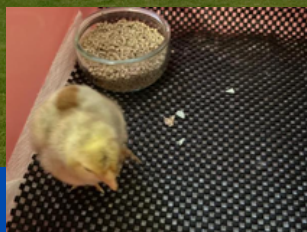
Thank you to everyone who nominated BPA to receive a World Book Day hamper from Morrisons which includes 10 books chosen by the National Literacy Trust.

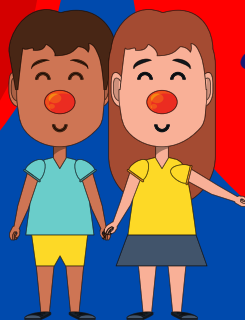
