

#### Exceptional leave during term time at Bramley Park Academy

We recognise that regular school attendance is vital. Children need to attend regularly if they are to enjoy the educational opportunities provided within the school and make consistently good progress. Absence can lead to educational disadvantage for a child and place them at risk of not achieving their full potential.

Cluster Attendance Policy regarding holidays is as follows.

Parents or Carers do not have the right to remove their children from school for a holiday.

The Executive Principal may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances

The Executive Principal will only authorise leave in EXCEPTIONAL circumstances and determine the number of school days a child can be away from school if the leave is granted. The Executive Principal should determine the number of school days a pupil can be away from school if the leave is granted.

Please come into school and request an exceptional circumstance form before you take your child out of school.

Thank you.

Exceptional leave will NOT be authorised under the following circumstances:

Ouring national and school tests
When a pupil's attendance is below 96%
Holidays during term time

The 2007 regulations state that each parent who fails to ensure their children's regular attendance at school or fails to ensure that their excluded child is not in a public place during the first five days of exclusion will result in a penalty notice of £60 if paid within 21 days; or £120 if paid within 28 days.

Regular school attendance is an important part of giving your child the best start in life.
