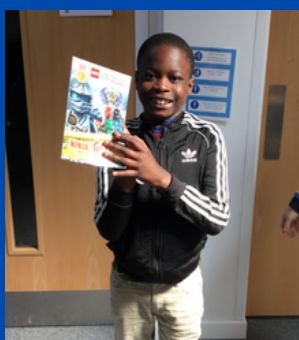

This week at Bramley

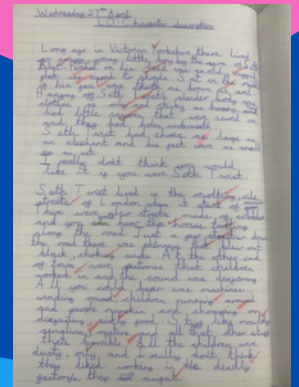
Well done to some of our Year 3 and Year 4 girls for coming 2nd in a football competition held at Leeds West Academy.
